## WHO WILL BE THERE?

Hello! I'm Tanya, Playgroup Coordinator for the Langley Infant Development Program. If you haven't been to playgroup before, you may be wondering what to expect when you arrive. I will be there at every group to welcome you and your child(ren) at the door. In addition, one of our IDP Consultants will also join me at each playgroup to answer any developmental questions and offer resources. We are available to listen and provide support as needed.

Look around the room, and you will see parents and caregivers connecting, supporting and sharing stories. Children are interacting and playing at various activity centres. New families and families that have been enjoying playgroup for some time. A place where accomplishments and milestones are not compared but celebrated every step of the way, no matter when they happen!

## HEALTH + SAFETY PROCEDURES

- Families must register for playgroups, with confirmation provided from Playgroup Coordinator before attending.
- At this time, there will be no drop-ins.
- Adults are required to wear a mask indoors.
- Children and parent/caregiver(s) should complete a Daily Health Check before attending playgroup sessions.
- Families must wash hands when arriving at playgroup and before snack.

## WHAT IS THERE TO DO?

For the children, there is always a wide variety of activities set up for all abilities. Tables with puzzles, shape sorters, manipulatives, etc. Play dough, sensory activities and art to explore and create with. Have a tea party in the dramatic play area or build a tower with blocks; there is so much fun to be had!

After having had some fun, it's time to clean up the toys, wash our hands and share a healthy snack. We serve a variety of food that is nut-free. In the last 15 minutes of playgroup, we gather to sing and rhyme at circle time, before it's time to sing goodbye!
